

I spent fifteen years in Las Vegas and added KMZQ, KFBI, KWNR and KFM to my resume there. I swore every summer was going to be my last when I lived in Las Vegas. I married my best friend and we had our two children, Justin and Randee, while living there. As anyone in radio will tell you it's really hard on a marriage. Mine was no different. I also did local record promotion for ABC Records in New Orleans and National Promotion for Fretone Records ( Disco Duck ) owned by Estelle Axton...
